
## How to Assemble your Paper Acrobatic "Twirlies"


Print this sheet and glue to sturdy cardboard such as a cereal box, or print on cardstock and glue an extra sheet to the back.

Cut out the balance bars. Cut out the slots carefully with a knife or scissors. Unlike these acrobats, its safest to remain seated while cutting out the toy. Score the dotted lines and fold. Slide the green clamps onto the ends of the base.

Cut out the acrobats. Poke a hole in the center and insert a round toothpick to half of its length. Add a drop of glue to hold the toothpick in place.


Place the acrobats at either end of the horizontal bars and give them a push to watch them show off their tricks!
