

## TWENTY YEARS ON THE FRONT LINES

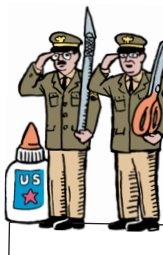

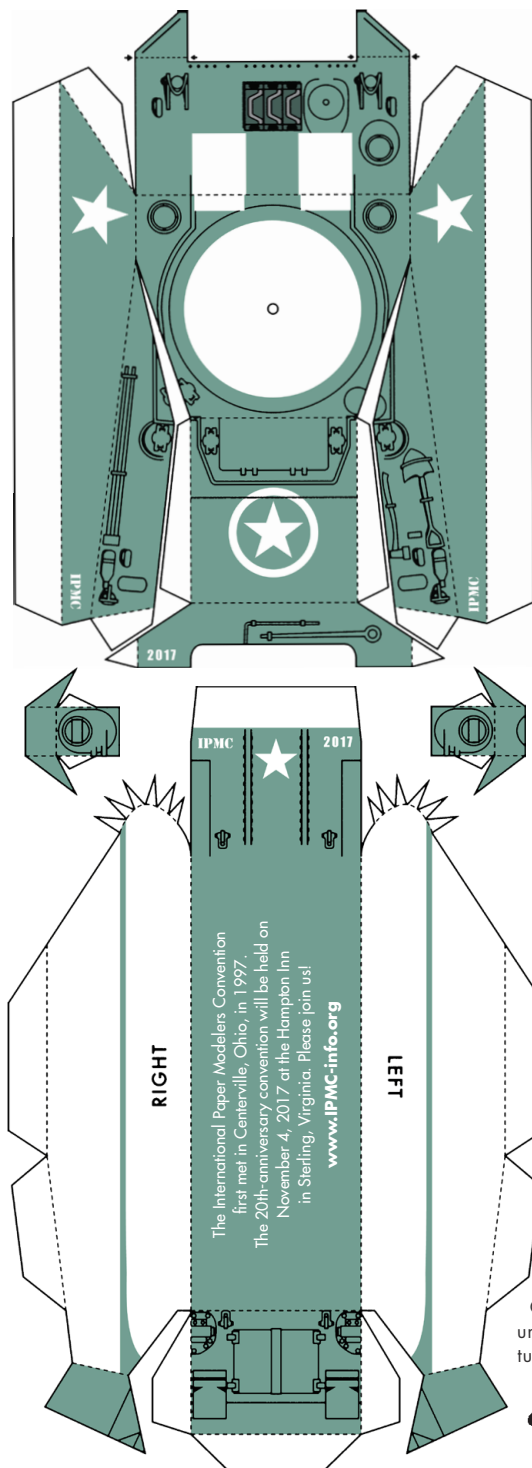
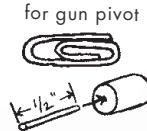
Edition: IPMC 2017



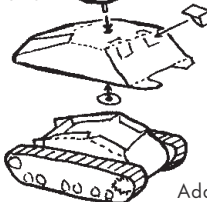
Fold the treads around the wheels then glue to the chassis



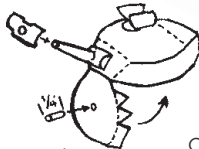
Cut half-inch wire for gun pivot



Glue washer under turret



Place gun pivot in turret from below



Add hatches and glue top to chassis

Cut toothpick for bottom swivel of turret and close
